**THREE DOs.
TWO DON'Ts.**

DO 1

Do keep your mobile switched off in places where it is likely to annoy other people,

in the cinema, in the classroom, in the exam hall.

DO 2

Do make sure your battery is charged up when you really need it.

DO 3

DON'T 1

Don't hand out your mobile number to every person you meet.
You might like a girl/boy one week and give her/him your number.
But what if you've gone off her/him?
She/he might pester you with calls for ages.
So think before you hand out your number.

DON'T 2

Don't make anyone feel left out if they don't have a mobile.
It isn't compulsory!
Make sure you pop round to visit friends, too.
